Bay Hope Emergency Preparedness Plan

In an effort to be prepared for any time of emergency at Bay Hope Day School has developed an emergency preparedness plan. The Emergency Preparedness Plan is posted in every classroom so our teachers are ready to act accordingly. The safety of our children is always our top priority.

Emergency Evacuation:

Children will **NOT** be released to anyone during an Emergency until the "all clear" has been given. Based on the type of Emergency and **IF** an evacuation is needed from the Day School building C, your children will be taken to one of two places.

On Campus: Children's Worship Center / Building B or Main Worship Center / Building A

Our 1st call will be to 911. When the children are out of harms way and safe, then the parents will be notified by phone or emergency text message and the local news stations will be notified with information and updates.
